**7.09 Codes of Conduct**

The Executive Director, in consultation with the Chair, the President, the General Counsel, and the Policy Manual Subcommittee, shall prepare and promulgate codes of conduct applicable to State Bar staff, volunteers, participants, and attendees who are attending, participating in, or working any State Bar event, meeting, or activity. The purpose of the codes of conduct shall be to provide a professional, harassment-free environment for everyone involved, regardless of race, sex, color, religion, national origin, age, military and/or veteran status, sexual orientation, gender identity, gender expression, disability, or other characteristic protected by applicable federal, state, or local law.

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
